2011/2012 Academic Year Holiday Schedule

- Day before Thanksgiving, Wednesday, November 23, 2011
- Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 24, 2011
- Day after Thanksgiving, Friday, November 25, 2011
- Christmas Holiday, Monday, December 26, 2011
- New Year's Holiday, Monday, January 2, 2012
- Good Friday, Friday, April 6, 2012
- Memorial Day, Monday, May 28, 2012

In addition to seven official holidays, supplemental holidays are offered as an employee benefit. Although the University is not officially closed, the additional days off for most of the community are Labor Day and the four days between the Christmas holiday and New Year's Holiday.

For 2011/2012, the supplemental days are:

- Labor Day Monday, September 5, 2011
- Christmas Tuesday, December 27 - Friday, December 30, 2011

Staff members who are required to work on supplemental holidays will be paid at their regular rate and provided alternate day(s) off. The President, Executive Vice President and Executive Vice President/Provost are responsible for determining the departments that should remain open and those that should close. In general, departments providing campus security, essential student services such as registration and business office and those who support Interterm/Intermester are required to work on supplemental holidays.
