SCHOLARSHIPS

Upon completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and acceptance into the program, all degree-seeking students in the SoM may be eligible for Graduate Scholarships. This is made possible by the generosity of benefactors of the SoM and the endowment of the University of Dallas. The scholarships also reflect the University's commitment to the SoM in its mission to meet the needs of the local church. One may also request a review of one's scholarship status, as need dictates.

OTHER ASSISTANCE

Through the years, students have received varied kinds of financial support from dioceses and parishes in the areas where the SoM offers courses. In addition, local and national Catholic organizations have also responded positively to requests. We encourage students to contact their pastors and members of various organizations to explore the possibility of receiving funds.

FINANCIAL AID
